



Using Kanopy on Roku



Kanopy is a collection of movies. Each month you can borrow a total of 10 items. Items are automatically returned at the end of their loan period.

Loan period: 3 days

Kanopy can be used on:

- Android mobile devices
- Apple mobile devices
- Amazon Kindle Fire devices
- Desktop or laptop computers (Windows, Mac and Chromebook)
- Streaming media players (Roku, Amazon Fire TV, Apple TV)

How to create a Kanopy account:

- On a computer or mobile device, open a web browser and go to www.kanopy.com
- 2) Click the orange "**Get Started**" button.
- 3) Click the orange "Find Your Library" button. Search by zip code 46168. From the search results, select Plainfield-Guilford Township Public Library. Click the orange "Select This Library" button to confirm.
- 4) Enter the number that's on the back of your Plainfield library card and click the orange "Continue" button.
- 5) Enter your name, e-mail address and password, then click the orange "Sign Up" button.
- 6) Check your e-mail account for a message from Kanopy (you may need to check your spam folder). Click the link in the message to verify your e-mail address.

How to set up Kanopy on Roku:

- Go to the Roku Channel Store. In the menu on the left side, click on "Search Channels".
 Find the Kanopy app (it is free) and click on "Add channel".
- 2) When it has finished installing, click on "Go to channel". Click the "Log In" button.
- 3) On your computer or mobile device, open a web browser and go to www.kanopy.com/link

Enter the link code that you see on your Roku's screen, then click the orange "**Link Device**" button. You will see a message that your device has been linked successfully.

4) Return to your Roku and begin using Kanopy.

How to navigate Kanopy:

There is a menu bar at the top of the screen to help you navigate Kanopy:

- —**Search (magnifying glass icon)** Search for a specific item.
- **-Home**—The homepage for the entire collection.
- —Browse—Browse by subject (documentaries, education, etc.)
- —My Lists—Has tabs for My Watchlist (items you've bookmarked) and Continue Watching (items you currently have checked out).
- -**Settings**-Has your account settings, including your library "membership".

How to borrow an item:

- Browse or search to find an item you want.
- Click on an item to see its details.
 Click on the orange "Play" button to borrow it. It will automatically begin playing.
- 3) The number of your remaining borrows for the month ("plays") will be updated in the upper right of the Kanopy screen.
